1. DANIEL 2:1-3

A Babylonian king has a mysterious dream but cannot remember its contents

2. DANIEL 2:4-7

He wants an interpretation - the magicians ask for the dream but the king cannot remember it

3. DANIEL 2:8-11

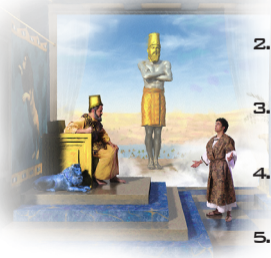
The magicians cannot provide an interpretation unless they are told the dream first

4. DANIEL 2:12-16

The king orders all the wise men killed - Daniel, a Jewish exile, asks for more time

5. DANIEL 2:17-30

Daniel prays to God, and that night God reveals the dream and interpretation to him

Legs of Iron - Roman Empire - 169 BC-476 AD
10. **DANIEL 2:33, 41-43**
Feet of Iron & Clay - Divided world - 476 AD - End of Time
11. **DANIEL 2:34-35, 44-45**
Rock - everlasting kingdom established by God
12. **REVELATION 22:1-5**
God establishes an eternal kingdom of peace and joy
