



- Irrelevant


It is important to know that church is *not*:

- The bride of Christ Jesus has a special love, devotion and care for the church.

- Gives us the opportunity to work together with other people using the spiritual gifts that the Holy Spirit has given you.


The Way the Bible Describes God's People




